

Criteria work placement	
1. Size	
a. Employed persons	At least 10 persons. Recognizable structure within the organization is desirable.
b. Professionalism	There must be professionalism or expertise within the organization to enable proper supervision of the work placement.
2. Work placement	Workplace in accordance with ARBO*); also presence of professional facilities required for the execution of the work placement (such as computer, means of communication).
3. Company supervisor	Qualifications focus on job level, job content, work experience and education, so that adequate guidance can be offered. Supervisor must have a bachelor or master degree.
4. International	<p>Dutch students have to go abroad and should remember that either the work placement or the activity in the third year semester 2, for example study abroad, must be in a French or German speaking country. If your choice is to do your Study Abroad in a German or French speaking country, it is allowed that the work placement is in English.</p> <p>International students can stay in the Netherlands or go abroad, except for their home country.</p>

*) ARBO an abbreviation of the Dutch word ARBeidsOmstandigheden = working conditions. These are the circumstances under which employees do their work. By working under the right working conditions, employees can function well. This prevents employees from falling out due to illness or an accident.
