Short description of the project assignment	 The focus will be at vocational education and food security in Uganda: Contribute to the further development of a soil game by several edcuational institutes in Uganda and the Netherlands. Activities linked to this assignment are: pretesting of the second prototype of the soil game in Uganda - desk research about didactics/gamification and collaborate with students who will focus at the design of the game Contribute to the further development of practical agricultural lessons for Hoys College, a secondary school in Bukomansimbi, Uganda. The lessons are being developed in close collaboration with Ugandan and Dutch educational institutes (like Wageningen University of Research and Zone.college). The team immerses itself in the SILC-concept and gives advise how to apply the concept in the Ugandan activities of WHC, Cibap and Zone.college.
What is the background of this project (in other words: why does the client needs this project)?	 UP4S collaborates amongst others with Dutch educational institutions (Zone, Cibap, WHC) on sustainable agribusiness, f.e. tree nursery, sustainable vegetable (school) gardens and beekeeping. These partner organizations have developed the educational concept Sustainable International Learning Community (SILC) where education is developed that allows students to connect and collaborate on SDGs and global citizenship. The background of this project is to support UP4S in developing a more practical AVET program, using the expertise of SILC network partners.
In what manner is this project addressing a complex issue?	Complexity lies in the multitude and involvement of different stakeholders – both Ugandan and Dutch. Also the uncertain developments of the Covid-19 epidemic could affect project activities in unforeseen ways, thus adding an extra layer of complexity.
