



5. Open the Authenticator app, at first use of the app tap on **Continue** and **Accept** and in the top right corner of the screen tap on **Skip** 




6. In the top right corner of the screen tap on the +, tap **Work or school account** and tap on **Scan QR code** 






At first use of the app you will be asked to allow the app to send you notifications, we advise you to allow these notifications for a smooth login experience.

7. Scan the QR-code and click Next on the website



8. Enter the 2-digit number on you smartphone as shown on the website and tap on Yes



9. On the website, click on Next and Done





You are advised to set up an alternative method. If your Microsoft Authenticator app suddenly stops logging you in, you can use the alternative method.


